Firm Roots Cancer Support

in The Link at St Mark's Lache and Saltney

We know cancer affects many people, both those who are diagnosed and those who are supporting them through their difficult journey. When cancer is first diagnosed it is overwhelming in its impact. It is undoubtedly a life changing experience and can often be a lonely and bewildering time.

St Mark's Lache and Saltney have set up a group to offer emotional and spiritual support to cancer sufferers and their care givers. The group is led by 3 people whose lives have been directly impacted by cancer.

The group is part of a larger Christian organisation known as Firm Roots www.firmroots.org.uk. Firm Roots was set up by Helen Jones in June 2012 as a direct response to her own personal journey with cancer. We are holding a special evening on 11th April (7.00-8.30pm) for church leaders in Cheshire and those involved in pastoral care. On that evening we are delighted that Helen will be coming to speak to our group and will share her personal journey along with her vision for outreach to those affected by cancer. The group meets on the second Monday of each month (except August), at St Mark's. This is an informal, café style evening led by members of the church whose lives have been directly affected by cancer. Anybody is welcome to attend this meeting.
