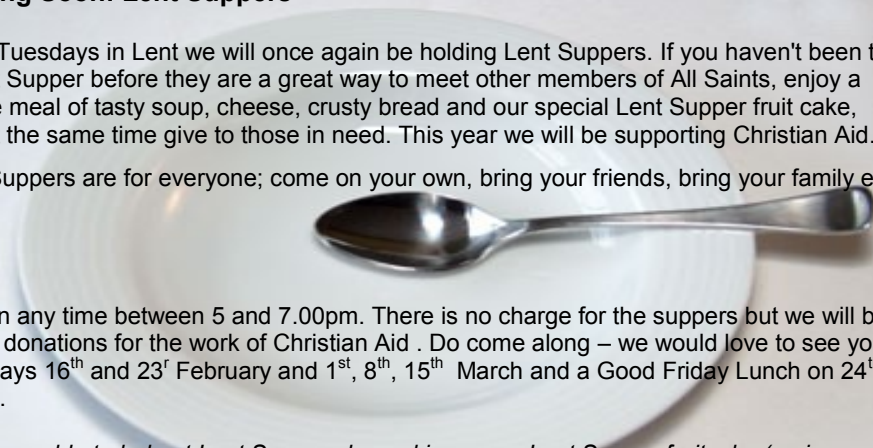
Coming Soon: Lent Suppers
