#### Church Evacuation Procedure!

In the unlikely event that we have a fire or other emergency on a Sunday in the church or church centre, it is really important that everyone knows what to do, and for obvious reasons it is rather difficult to organise a fire practice! We have therefore developed a plan for this event, and here is a brief summary:

- If you are a child or young person in Sunday Club, your leaders will be responsible for you, and you will exit the building via one of the church centre
- If you are in the main church, you will be guided by the Welcomers to exit the building by either the Tower or Hoole Road exit.
- If you are in a wheelchair or have additional needs, someone will help you exit the building by the vestry door if you are near the front.
- It is really important that the door between the church and the church centre is not clogged up in an emergency, and therefore this door must **not** be used.
