Announcing our next 'Chester Deo Grattias Choir' concert on Saturday November 28th at All Saints Church. It's rather a special one, as we're privileged to have Jonathan Veira as our guest. Jonathan is a super bass-baritone of international fame - he's sung in most of the opera houses in the world, sung on TV, made a number of CDs and he's just published his second book.

He's also very funny - a great entertainer. Our choir will be singing some things on their own, Jonathan will join them in some items as a soloist and he will do quite a lot on his own. His repertoire is varied - e.g. songs from shows, operas [he particularly likes the 'comic' roles], as well as some Christian and other 'classic' songs, though I don't yet know what he'll actually sing at this concert. It will be good, whatever he chooses to do.

He has a website which you might like to check out - it's www.jonathanveira.com. On this you can hear him sing, listen to interviews - e.g. one with Aled Jones outside the Royal Albert Hall before a BBC 'Songs of Praise', and generally get a flavour of the man. He's lovely!
